

Hello Parents and Campers of Day Camp!

We are so excited to have a fun filled summer! We have been planning a great camp experience! The giant swing, rock wall, and pool are just some of the fun things that we will be doing during the week and we want you to be prepared.



Check In

Drive thru style in the main parking lot.

Monday - 8:45am, Tuesday through Friday - 9:00am

We ask for parents to remain in the car and wait until a staff member has checked in your camper.

Before Arriving Monday:

- Complete all forms in CampWise
- Pay any remaining camp fee in CampWise
- Have any medications and related documentation ready to give to the nurse

At check in on Monday you will be given a check-out tag for your car. Please keep this in your car all week to speed up the check-out process.

Check Out

Drive thru style in the main parking lot.

Monday through Friday - 5:00pm

(Week 3 – Water Week there will be NO CAMP on Friday, July 4th)

At check out you will need to show the camper check-out tag given out on Monday **OR** you will need to show your photo ID and sign your camper out. Please place the camper check-out tag on your dashboard of your vehicle.

We understand many parents/friends have playdates or help each other with transportation during the week. Please understand that for the safety of all our campers, only those listed on the Authorized to pick up camper section of the form will be able to check out the camper.

What to Bring

Day campers will need to PACK THEIR OWN LUNCHES each day. We will be eating outside at picnic tables (indoors in bad weather). Water will be available for campers throughout the day.

As most of our day will be outside, please **be prepared for the weather.** We suggest each camper bring a backpack with the following:

- Change of Clothes
- Bathing Suit/Towel
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Water Bottle
- Closed Toed Shoes and Sandals
- Hat

Please keep in mind that campers need to wear clothes that can get messy. We will swim each day Monday – Friday so campers will need a swimsuit/towel every day.

What NOT to Bring

Please do not allow your camper to bring: knives, pocket knives, hatchets, axes, matches, lighters, fireworks, drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, vaping products, valuable or irreplaceable items, or electronics including: **CELL PHONES**, portable video games, music players, or any device that can connect online while at camp.

CAMP STORE

Camper's tuition will include 1 drink and 1 snack at the camp store each afternoon, so please do not send any money with campers. You can put extra funds on their Campwise Store credit account in order for them to purchase t-shirts, trinkets, and souvenirs which range from \$1-\$30. **PLEASE KNOW – Any remaining funds UNDER \$10 will be automatically donated to our summer mission fund and not refunded or moved to future camp sessions.**
